

WHEN TO USE SPRS

The **SmartPay Payroll Reporting Service (SPRS)** is designed for policyholders whose payroll providers don't directly integrate with our pay-as-you-go billing solution. SPRS is a simple, optional payroll reporting service that ensures accurate payroll reporting each pay cycle.

To be eligible for SPRS, policyholders need a Workers' Compensation Report that includes subject wages by state and class code. ADP, Paychex and Intuit are a few of many vendors where SPRS is applicable. In cases where a Workers' Compensation Report isn't available, alternative reports may be accepted under certain conditions.

For an annual fee of \$350 (*effective February 1, 2025*), SmartPay will work with policyholders to establish payroll reporting processes, ensuring seamless reporting each pay cycle.
